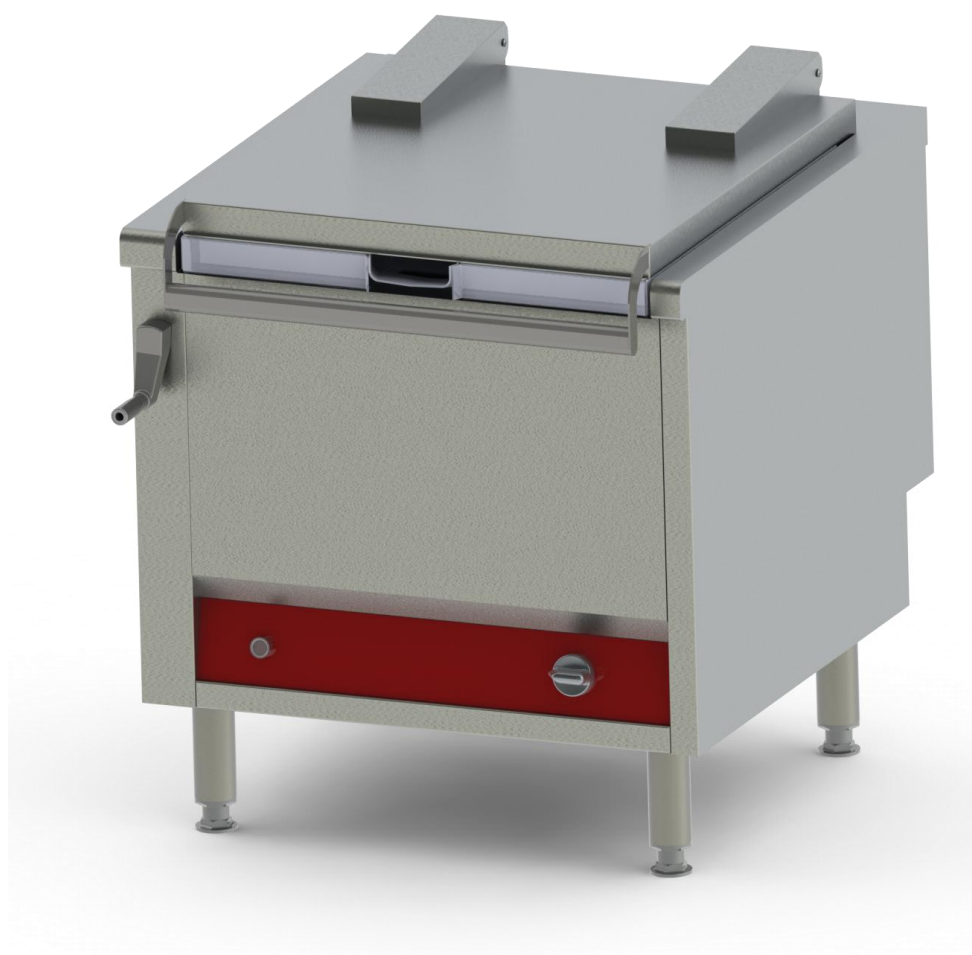

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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1. INSTALLATION

1.1. General points

The appliance must be installed in an adequately aerated room, equipped with an air extraction system, in compliance with regulations and standards in force in the country of installation, and with the instructions contained in this manual.

The user's manual must be given to the user after installation.

1.2. Handling - Installation

It is imperative to leave the appliance on its wooden pallet during the handling process until the final installation.

Unpack and check the appliance for damage upon receipt.

In case of damage, detail them immediately on the delivery note; notify the carrier by registered mail with acknowledgement of receipt within 48 hours.

1.3. Installation

Special attention must be paid to the local fire prevention regulations of the organization concerned (see [Public Access Premises]).

The appliance must be installed under a suitable aspiration hood.

If the appliance is to be installed against a wall or partition, near a piece of furniture or decorative borders, it is recommended that these be of a fireproof material.

If this is not the case, they must be protected by an approved fireproof, insulating material.

If in doubt of fireproof construction of adjacent walls, distance to combustible material shall be no less than 10 cm.

Remove all plastic protection. Install the appliance in the work place.

Warning

- **Fixed appliance:**

Install the feet or the levelling studs (these are delivered in a separate box).
Level the appliance by adjusting the height of the feet until the working surface is level horizontally.

- **WARNING:**

Independent module units must be fixed to the wall.

- **Mobile appliance:**

Install the castors (these are delivered in a separate box).
The castors with brakes must be locked when the appliance is being connected and at all times during cooking.

**Any intervention or repair on an appliance must be undertaken by a qualified installer.
The appliance shall be isolated from the electrical supply by stopping the power grid.**

When the appliance is ready for use, ensure the users know how to use it properly.
(Please see the User's Manual.)

Warranty : The warranty is discussed in our sale contract.

This warranty does not cover damage due to faulty installation, misuse or inadequate maintenance.

1.4. Data plate

Each appliance has its own data plate. Transfer all the information written on the data plate to the last page of the user's manual.

This will facilitate communication between you and your client for better service.



2. POWER CONNECTION

Warnings:

The appliance must be earth-wired.
It is dangerous to connect the appliance unless it is earthed.
We cannot be held responsible for accidents due to non-existent or incorrect earth link connection.

Fixed appliance:

Check that the electrical network is equipped with all-pole circuit breakers with a contact opening distance that is compliant with the European Standard EN 60335-1.

CAUTION:

Use a standardized cable (245 IEC 57 or 245 IEC 66) or any other approved cable with the same characteristics.

All controls and checks below are done when the appliance is switched off and cold.

2.1. Checks before connection

Check that:

- The electrical voltage of the grid is compatible with the voltage of the appliance (see § 4.4).
- The cable is fixed properly,
- The connections are tight enough,
- The cross-section of the electrical cable is compatible with the power of the appliance.

2.2. Connecting the appliance to the power grid

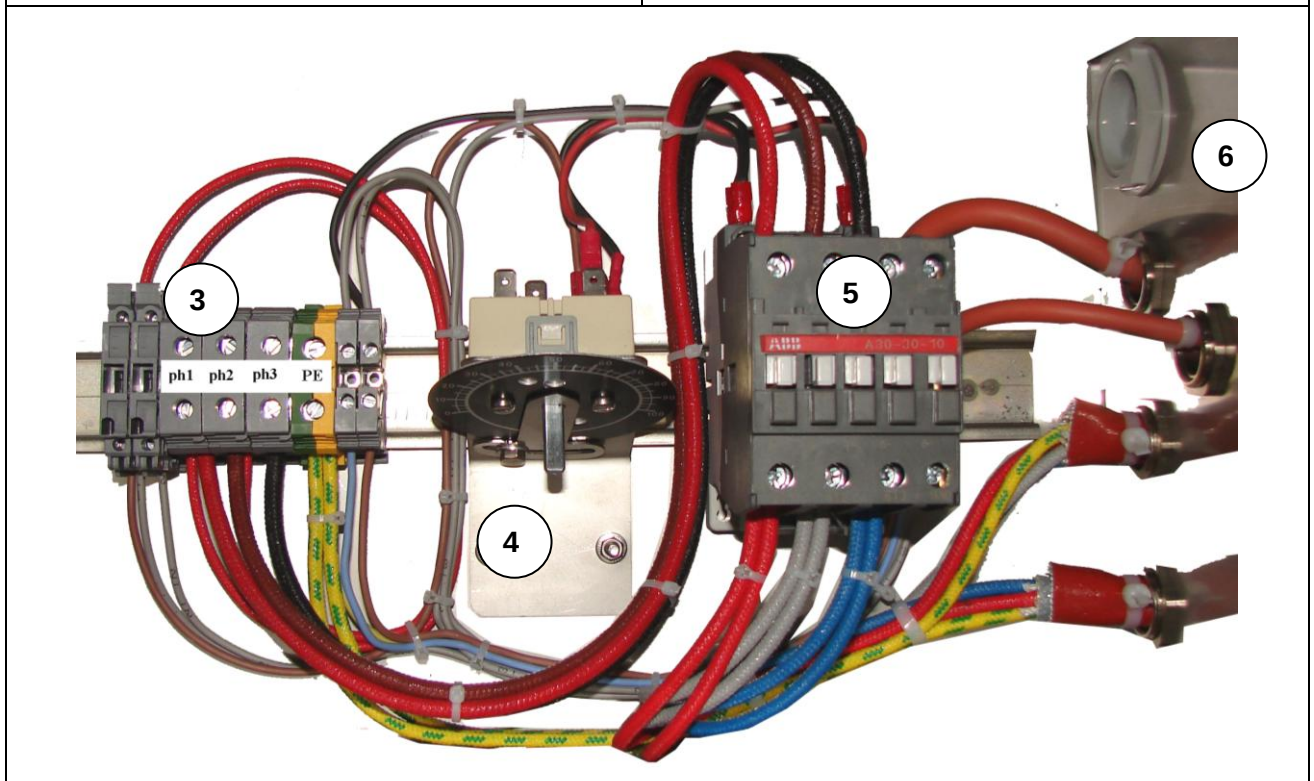
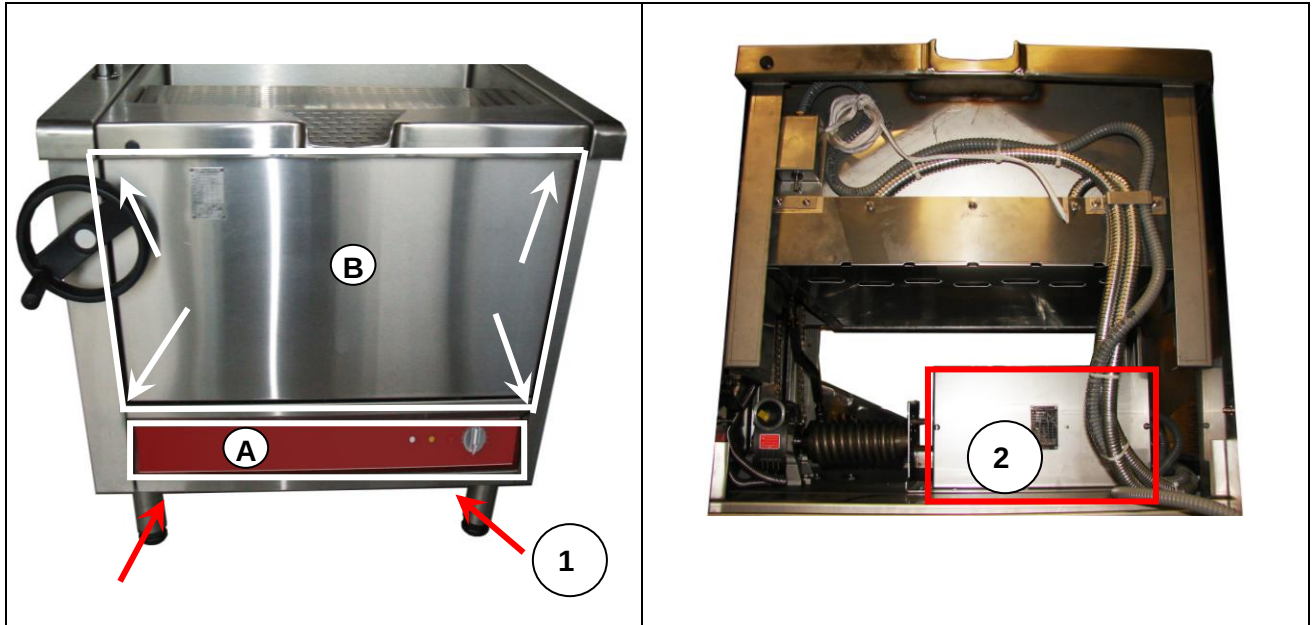
Unscrew the front panel to access the junction box.

Place the cable into the junction box (fixed with 2 screws).

Connect the power cable to the terminals, following the information written on the box (see figures below).

Before reassembling the parts, check that the electrical equipment is properly insulated (condition of the cables).

- The appliance is in good working condition (ignition, etc.),

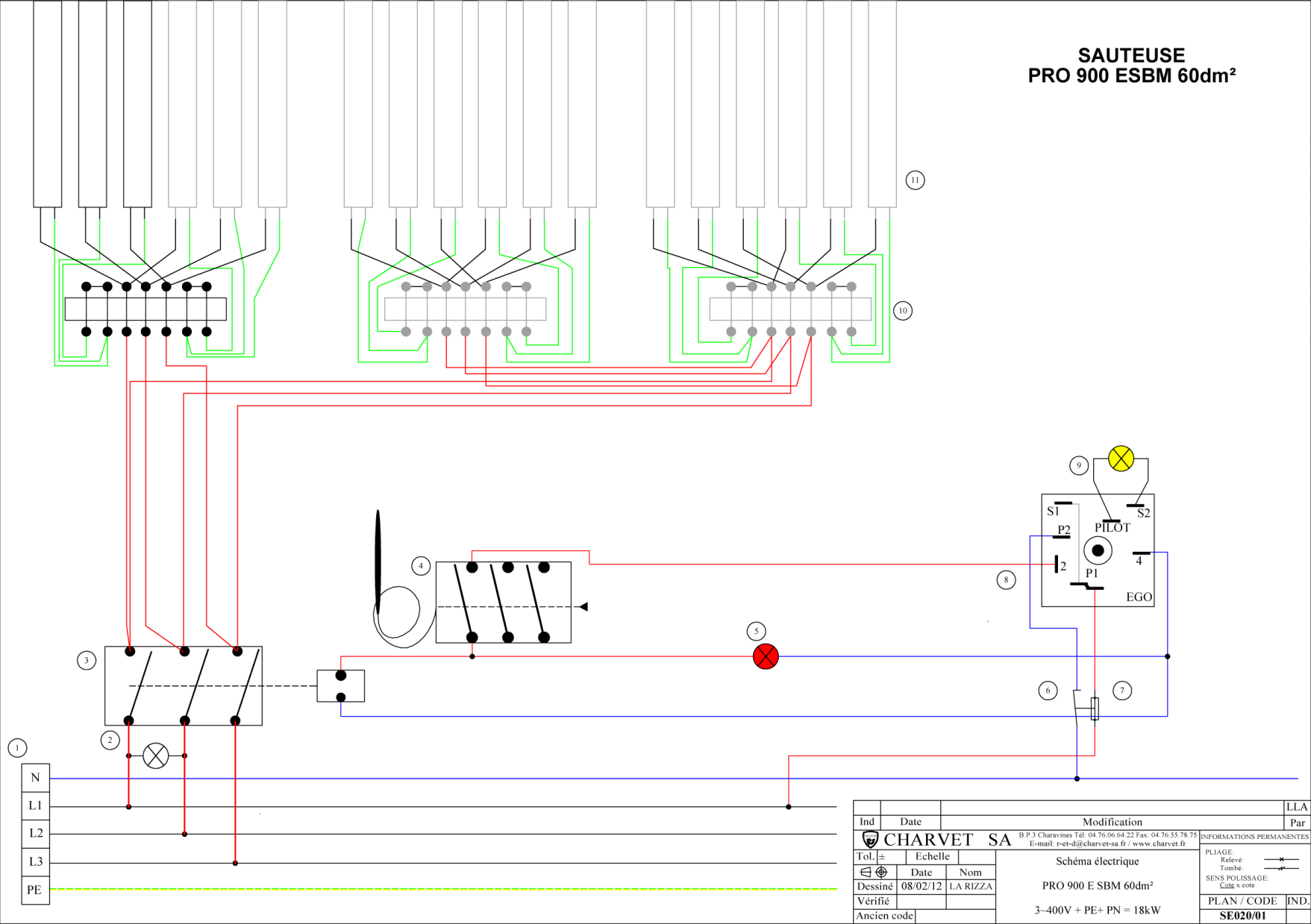

USER INSTRUCTIONS

Warnings

***It is important to turn off the heating element before each cleaning.
Do not heat the tank for an extended period of time whilst empty.***

**The bratt pan should not be used for deep frying. (European Standard EN 203-2-8)
Misuse can cause severe damage to the appliance or put in danger goods and people around.
We cannot be held responsible if the user(s) neglect to follow these instructions.**

About the regulation option: when the maximum temperature is reached, the red heating indicator turns off and the second energy regulator maintains the temperature at 350°C.
Set the energy regulator on the control panel to 80% to avoid overloading the tank.

1. INTRODUCTION:

- A) Our appliances are for professional use only and must be used by qualified staff.
- B) The appliances must be installed in compliance with regulations and standards in force in the country of installation, in an adequately aerated room, equipped with an air extraction hood.
- C) Appliances may be installed side by side or against walls of non-combustible material but they must remain at a distance of no less than 10 cm to combustible material.
- D) It is imperative to hire a qualified installer for all new installations or modifications of existing equipment.
- E) WARRANTY: *The warranty is discussed in our sale contract. Call a registered dealer for any warranty work. This warranty does not cover damage due to faulty installation, misuse or inadequate maintenance.*

2. PRIOR TO STARTING UP

- a) Remove all plastic protection wrapping the stainless steel panels.
 - b) Make sure that all controls are in good working condition.
 - c) Prior to starting up, it is advisable to clean the appliance in order to eliminate all dust and impurities that have accumulated during storage.
- To this end, fill up the tank with water (1-2 cm high).
- d) Turn the appliance on (for about 10 minutes).
 - e) Then, turn it off.
 - f) Tilt the tank to drain (see tank tilting § 3.2.).
 - g) Clean the tank with a sponge to eliminate all remaining impurities.

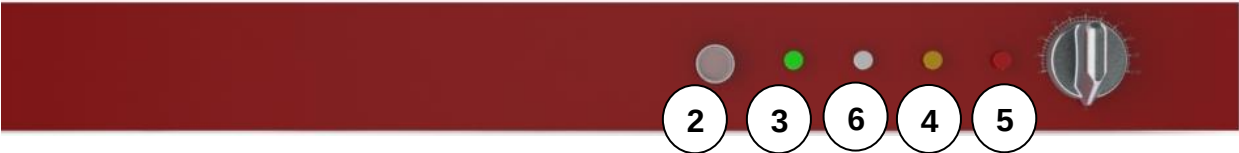
3. STARTING UP

3.1. Electric bratt pan:

The appliance is ON (white indicator)

- a) Set the energy regulator control knob to the "100" mark (continuous heating); the yellow indicator (the energy regulator is switched on) and the red one (the apparatus is heating up) are alight.

The preheating phase lasts about 15 minutes; you can start cooking after this period of time. Temperature is evenly distributed on the cooking plate to allow cooking operations across the whole surface.

Warning: When opening the lid during "wet" cooking operations, be careful of the escaping steam to avoid any risk of burns as the arm passes over the tank.

When emptying:

- Stay clear of the cooked product pouring zone: risk of splash burns.
- Follow tank movement to control pouring in the spout area.
- Tilt the tank backwards to its idle position to avoid spillage of products when changing collecting containers.

The tank sides may be very hot after an intensive and extended period of use; use only the tilting handle to tilt the tank.

4. SWITCHING OFF

Bring the command knob back to the position: 0
Wait until cooking areas have cooled down to a bearable temperature.
Clean the tank carefully after each use
(Avoid drying of food scraps and overflowing liquids).

At the end of the day, switch the power off at the mains.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Cleaning of the stainless steel surfaces:

- a) Switch off the appliance.
- b) Wait until the apparatus has cooled down before any intervention.
- c) Wash with a sponge and soapy water (or any other neutral detergent).

Do not use bleach or any other acidic product - even well diluted.

For the top parts, use a scouring pad if necessary. **Always scour with the grain.**

- d) After each cleaning, rub with an oily rag.
- e) Finger marks can be removed with a cloth dabbed with alcohol.

5.2. Cleaning the tank

Cleaning can be done by soaking with soapy water.

If coarse salt is poured into the tank during dry-cooking or semi-moist cooking, thoroughly rinse the bottom of the tank with clear water to remove all salt particles. Otherwise it will corrode the stainless steel tank.

5.3. Cleaning the burner

If the burner needs to be cleaned, please call your installer.

**The burner must not be cleaned with splashes or water jets under pressure.
Check that the appliance is powered off at the mains.**

THE ENGINE OF THE ELECTRIC ACTUATOR MUST NOT BE SUBJECTED TO SPLASHES. AS THERE IS A RISK OF ENGINE DETERIORATION.

For best results, it is advisable to have your equipment serviced by a qualified installer on a regular basis depending on the intensity of utilization.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1. Unsatisfactory heating:

The switched-on indicator is alight but the tank is not heating up:

- . ***Incorrectly positioned tank:*** manoeuvre the tank using the tilting handle to engage the positioning microswitch, .

- . Energy regulator failure,
- . Overheat thermostat failure (regulator indicator off)
- . Heater contactor failure.

BADLY DISTRIBUTED HEAT:

- . Faulty heating elements.

Contact the installer in order to replace command parts or heating elements for further use.



Only a qualified electrician can replace the ignition transformers.

The manufacturer and the installer cannot be held responsible if the user fails to ask for assistance in case of malfunction.
